Auditions for all speaking roles will be held on Sun., Feb. 4th | 2p-5p. Callbacks (if needed) will be on Mon., Feb. 5th | 5-6pm.

(Students who do not desire a speaking role should not attend the auditions. There are a generous amount of ensemble and dancer roles that will suit all of the students!)

Audition Requirements

Doors will open at 1:45p and you will audition in the order in which you arrive. Please bring your completed audition form and your sheet music for the accompanist. You do not need to bring a headshot or photograph.

Break a leg and have fun!

Part I is a Vocal Audition:

Students should come prepared to sing 32 bars (measures) of a Disney song. Please do not sing anything from ALADDIN. When selecting your song, please be sure that you have the sheet music in the appropriate key to bring to your audition. If you need sheet music go online to musicnotes.com, sheetmusicplus.com, or sheetmusicdirect.com. An accompanist will be provided. A cappella (unaccompanied) singing is not recommended. Singing with karaoke tracks is not allowed.

Part II is a Movement Audition:

Students will be taught a simple dance/movement combination in class on Thurs., Feb. 1st that they will perform in small groups at the audition. This is a chance to show personality and character! Don't be afraid, just have fun and SHINE!

Part III is either a cold-reading from the script at the auditions, or some students will be asked to attend the callbacks on Mon., Feb. 5th.

Associated Class Costs:

If you are only enrolled in Triple Threats....

- The semester tuition is \$220.00 plus a \$25 materials/costume fee for a total of \$245.00.
- Tuition can be made in 5 monthly payments of \$44 each and is due on Jan. 25th, Feb. 22, March 22, April 19, May 10
- ❖ The \$25 costume/materials fee is due on or before March 1st.
- ❖ If you are new to the studio, there is also a non-refundable registration fee of \$20. This fee is due with your first tuition payment on Jan. 25th.
- Students are required to wear jazz (tan for girls, black for boys) shoes for rehearsals and performances. If you need to purchase these shoes, please see Ms. Lynne or Ms. Monica to be measured. Jazz shoes are \$35 and MW uses the Revolution brand.

If you are enrolled in multiple classes...

- You will continue to follow the class tuition chart.
- Please speak with Ms. Lynne or Ms. Monica if you have questions about your account.
- Students in multiple classes will also pay the \$25 costume/materials fee. This fee is due on or before March 1st.
